Eligibility Requirements are as follows:

- 1. Must be a resident of the counties of St Clair, Monroe, Randolph or Washington Counties in Illinois.**
- 2. Must be enrolled or enrolling in a mental health field of study. Examples include but are not limited to Clinical or Counseling Psychologist, Marriage or Family Therapist, Clinical Social Worker, Psychiatric RN, Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner, Psychiatrist, Registered Nurse or Mental Health Counselor.**
- 3. Must be a graduating May, 2023 Senior or Currently Enrolled College Student in the above named fields of study.**
- 4. Must write a minimum three page essay on what led you to seek this area of study and how you hope to influence and aid others with their mental health challenges. All papers will remain confidential except to be reviewed by the Craig Range Foundation Board of Directors for selection.**
- 5. Must include your name, address, phone number, name of school currently enrolled, graduating year and school representative's name and phone number for verification purposes.**
