We are pleased to inform you of the release of our annual \$2,000 scholarship opportunity, the Thomas H. Moore Illinois Electric Cooperatives (IEC) Memorial Scholarship program for a total of \$34,000 to be given away. Scholarships are available to high school seniors on behalf of Egyptian Electric Cooperative (EECA) and our statewide association, Association of Illinois Electric Cooperatives (AIEC). This year the number of scholarships increased from 15 to 17. Of the 17 scholarships to be awarded, sixteen (16) are educational and one (1) is for aspiring lineworkers:

- Ten (10) will be awarded to students who are enrolling full-time at a two-year or a four-year college, university, or vocational/technical school who are the children of an Illinois electric cooperative consumer-member receiving service from the Cooperative;
- Five (5) will be reserved for children enrolling full-time at an Illinois community college who are the children of an Illinois electric cooperative consumer-member receiving service from the Cooperative;
- One (1) "Earl W. Stuck Memorial Scholarship" enrolling full-time at a two-year or a four-year college, university, or vocational/technical school who is the child of an Illinois electric cooperative employee or director; and
- One (1) "LaVern & Nola McEntire Memorial Lineworker's Scholarship"

All academic scholarship applicants must be planning to enroll in a full-time (at least 12 hours) undergraduate course of study at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or vocational/technical school for the fall 2024 semester. The deadline for the sixteen (16) academic scholarship applications is December 31, 2023, and submissions are to be completed online. Please note, once the application process is started online, it cannot be stopped or paused. The 17th scholarship, the LaVern & Nola McEntire Memorial Lineworker's Scholarship, is due April 30, 2024.

1 scholarship, the LaVern and Nola McEntire Lineworker's Scholarship, is awarded to a student to attend the lineworker's school conducted by the Association of Illinois Electric Cooperatives in conjunction with Lincoln Land Community College, Springfield, IL (deadline to apply April 30, 2024).
